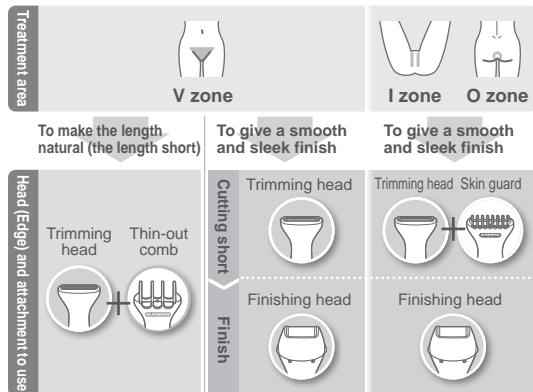

Combine heads (edges) and attachments, and you will receive the intended care!

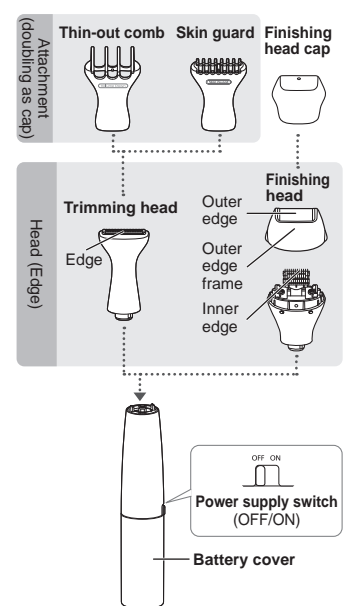


* If the trimming head is used

Warning

- Do not push the outer edge hard, nor touch it with your finger or nail during use. (Doing so may damage your skin or shorten the life of the outer edge.)
- Do not touch the cutting part (metal part) of the inner edge with your hand. (Doing so may damage your hand.)
- Be sure to attach a cap when carrying or storing this product.
- Do not use this product on sensitive or delicate skin, or people with a predisposition to allergy.
- Do not share this product with family members or other people. (Doing so may result in infection or inflammation.)
- Use this product only to care for the V/I/O zone. Before use, check the edges for deformation and damage.
- Use a mirror or take an appropriate posture to check hard-to-see areas before starting care. (Failure to do so may damage your skin or cause inflammation or bleeding.)
- Avoid the following areas.
 - Sexual organ, anus, or mucous membrane other than labia majora
 - Scratch, eczema, mole, bruise, wart, pimple, or the like, and its surroundings
 - Sag of your skin
- During and after use, if any abnormality appears on your skin, stop using this product and consult a dermatologist. (Failure to do so may cause the condition to get worse.)
- When using the trimming head in the I/O zone, be sure to attach the skin guard.
- Observe the following during use.
 - Stretch your skin to smooth it out.
 - Do not press this product hard against your skin but move it slowly.
 - Do not rub the same area repeatedly. Avoid tapping.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals. (Doing so may result in burns or injury.)
- Follow the precautions indicated on the battery.
- Check the polarity of the battery and insert it correctly.
- Remove the depleted battery immediately.
- Remove the battery when not using for an extended period of time.
- Use a dry battery that is within the recommended usage period.
- When using a rechargeable nickel-metal hydride battery, read the battery and charger instruction manuals and use them correctly. (Failure to do so may result in injury or stains around the battery due to heat generation, rupture, or leakage of the battery.)

Basic Use

If your hair is wet, some of the hairs will stick to your skin or bunch up, making it hard to cut them. In addition, they may not be cut in uniform length.

Dry shaving is recommended.

Preparation Select a head (edge) and an attachment that suit your purpose.

- Attach the head (edge) and the attachment.
- Turn "ON" the switch.
- Stretching a target area with your hand, move the unit gently and slowly to shave the skin.
 - If your hair is lying, brush back the hair from bottom to top to raise it before use.
 - Kept in close contact with your skin, the head (edge) and attachment should be moved slowly.
- When you are finished with the product, Turn "OFF" the switch.
 - Clean it after use.

How to Attach/Detach Attachments

How to attach

- Insert a head (edge) into an attachment firmly as far as the cutting edge will go.
- Holding the attachment, push in the encircled portion firmly with your finger until you hear a click.

Check that the attachment does not come off.

How to detach

Pull and detach the attachment.

Push in with your finger

How to Care for V/I/O Zone

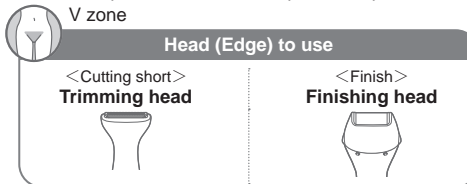
To give a smooth and sleek finish

Point /

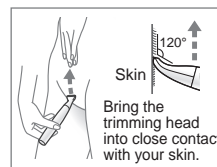
Stretch a target area tight with your hand, and you can shave the skin well.

Notes

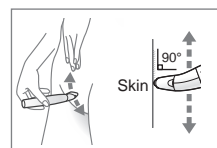
- If your hair remains longish after cutting with the trimming head, it may not be finished smoothly and sleekly.



- With the trimming head, cut your hair short to 1.5 mm or less.
 - Put the edge in the roots of the hair, and move this "slowly" keeping it in close contact with your skin.



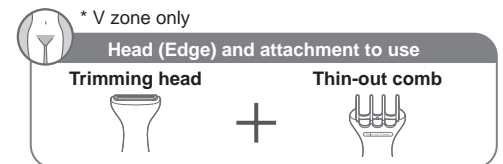
- With the finishing head, put the final shaving.
 - Bring the edge in contact with your skin at right angles, and move this "slowly" up and down.



To make the length natural (the length short)*

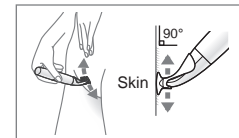
Point /

Stretch a target area tight with your hand, and you can shave the skin well.



- Attach the thin-out comb to the trimming head.

- Cut your hair.
 - Bring the thin-out comb in contact with your skin at right angles, and move this "slowly" up and down.



How to Care for V/I/O Zone (cont.)

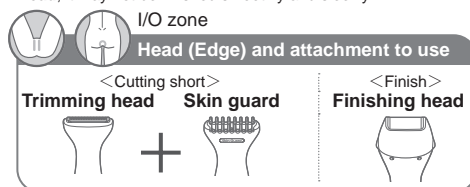
To give a smooth and sleek finish

Point /

Stretch a target area tight with your hand, and you can shave the skin well.

Notes

- If your hair remains longish after cutting with the trimming head, it may not be finished smoothly and sleekly.



- Attach the skin guard to the trimming head.

- Cut your hair short to 1.5 mm or less.
 - Bring the skin guard in contact with your skin at right angles, and move this "slowly" up and down.



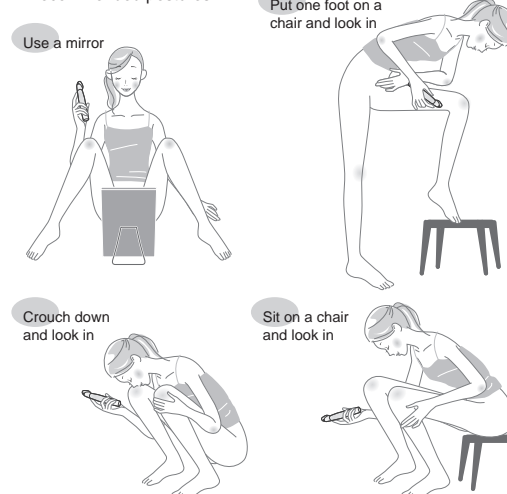
- With the finishing head, put the final shaving.
 - Bring the edge in contact with your skin at right angles, and move this "slowly" up and down.



Notes

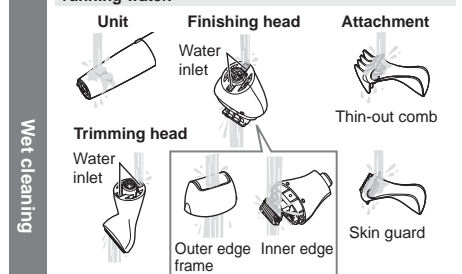
- When using the trimming head in the I/O zone, be sure to attach the skin guard.
- Do not press this product hard against your skin even with the skin guard attached. Doing so may damage your skin.

Recommended postures



Cleaning

Rinse the unit, attachments, and heads (edges) with running water.



After wiping water drops off with a towel or the like, dry them naturally.

- After wet cleaning, apply a drop of dedicated oil (optional) to the outer edge of the finishing head and to the trimming head, turn "ON" the switch, and run the product for 2 to 3 seconds.

Brush hair shavings off with the cleaning brush.
